Bio-stimulant properties of kelp in this formula boost growth at all stages, promotes flowering, rooting, and overall plant vitality. This product is widely used in foliar and drip programs to boost overall plant growth at any stage from propagation to fruit-filling.

Suggested Application Rates & Method

- Seedlings: Use 1.5-2 mL Power Kelp per liter as a showering drench
- Drip: Based on frequency, use 200-500 mL per 10,000 sq. ft. growing space along with main feed
- 50-75 mL Power Kelp per 100 linear ft. row
- Foliar (open field): Use 1-1.5 L Power Kelp in a fog

Special Notes

- If used in nutrient tanks, keep the solution aerated or agitated
- In the mixing sequence, add Power Kelp last
- Run a small rinse cycle after using any organic liquid in drip or spray tanks
- Check compatibility before mixing with other products, especially with pesticides and water-soluble fertilizers
- To avoid staining, do not spray open blooms of ornamental crops
- Consult an agronomist or crop consultant for best advice based on local farm or garden conditions
- Ideal companion product for Power Kelp is K-43
